BUKIT BATOK RESIDENTS, SWEDISH MNCS & LOCAL SMES JOIN HANDS TO LAUNCH A GREEN INNOVATION CENTRE IN THE HEARTLANDS

Bukit Batok Community and 13 Swedish businesses have joined forces to launch the Bukit Batok Green Innovation Centre at Bukit Batok Zone 2 Residents' Network (RN) Cosy Garden, the first of its kind. This **unique partnership between Bukit Batok Grassroots Organisations, South West Community Development Council (CDC) and Swedish Chamber of Commerce (SwedCham) Singapore** aims to promote and showcase sustainable urban living and practices to support the Singapore Green Plan 2030.

As the first pilot Green Innovation Centre in the South West District, this collaboration is a joint effort to transform the existing Cosy Garden, *a well-established community garden in Bukit Batok that has been lovingly built by residents and local volunteers over the past decade*, into a hub to inspire local community to learn and discover more on sustainable living. Guest of Honour, Ms Low Yen Ling, Minister of State, Ministry of Trade and Industry & Ministry of Culture, Community and Youth and Mayor of South West District together with Host Adviser, Mr Murali Pillai, Adviser to Bukit Batok Grassroots Organisations (GROs), will launch the centre on **Thursday, 8 June 2023, at 10.00am.**

3 The launch will showcase the key features of the centre which include *rainwater harvesting, smart pest control, therapeutic gardening, implementation of low carbon pathways, installation of a solar energy loop and circular solutions such as an outdoor living room built from recycled materials.* This unique collaborative initiative is made possible through the sponsorship of 13 Swedish Multinational Corporations (MNCs) linked by SwedCham. Following the launch, the partners together with RN volunteers and gardeners will organise a series of community workshops on *packaging recycling, circular fashion and healthy eating & food waste* over the coming months.

4 Calling it a step forward for sustainable living in the heartlands, Mayor Low Yen Ling said "This initiative demonstrates the collaborative power of the 3Ps – People, Public and Private - coming together to drive and promote greater sustainability in the heartlands. Together, South West CDC, members of SwedCham, Bukit Batok Grassroots Organisations and students from our district have turned the community garden into a living model of sustainability for residents to see, touch and experience for themselves. Concepts such as a closed energy loop and circular economy are brought alive by the installation of new features such as solar panels and a rainwater harvesting system in the garden. In addition, educational eco workshops will equip residents to pursue a more eco-friendly lifestyle."

5 Mayor Low added that the new Green Innovation Centre in Bukit Batok's Cosy Garden was aligned with the Singapore Green Plan 2030 and Sustainable South West Masterplan. She said, "We hope this successful initiative will serve as a blueprint for more such community gardens in our district as we work towards shaping a greener and more sustainable Singapore."

6 President of Swedish Chamber of Commerce Singapore and Vice-President Holding SEA & Oceania, Atlas Copco, Mr Horst Wasel shared, "At the heart of this project is the firm belief in partnerships to drive change. We will only manage to build a sustainable future by coming together. Individually, we can take small steps, but when we do it side by side with others, we have the opportunity to make more meaningful change. This is about setting an example of how businesses, governments, and people can join forces to make a tangible difference."
